You have the right to refuse to contribute without reprisal. The law requires political committees to report the following information for individuals whose contributions exceed \$100: name, address, occupation and employer. All information will be kept confidential unless required by law. You must be a US Citizen or a person lawfully admitted for permanent residency in the United States. Personal contributions over \$200 must be reported to the FEC.
